## Culturally and Linguistically Inclusive Schools

## **Course Objectives**

- create a values statement about their personal and professional beliefs related to fostering globally-minded perspective and supporting newcomer learners;
- respond to newcomer and language learner profiles by providing next steps to support students;
- create an action plan for their continued learning and enhanced practice that responds to learner global-perspective, newcomer learners, and/or language learners.
